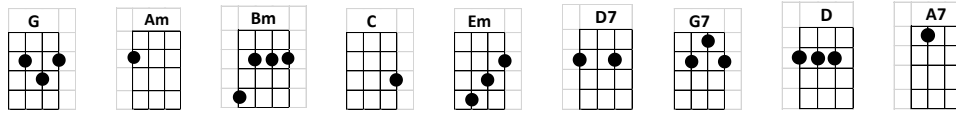


Daydream Believer
